IN THE MATTER OF a Hearing to review the evidence to be provided by New Brunswick Power Corporation in connection with a proposal to refurbish its generating facility at Coleson Cove.

ORDER

WHEREAS New Brunswick Power Corporation ("NB Power") has applied to the Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities (the "Board") by Application dated the 12 th day of July 2001 for a public hearing on the evidence to be provided in connection with the proposal to refurbish its generating facility at Coleson Cove.

AND WHEREAS NB Power is required, pursuant to Subsection 40.1(1.1) of the Public Utilities Act, Chapter P-27 RSNB ("the Act") to make application to the Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities ("the Board") before making an expenditure exceeding \$75 million for the maintenance or upgrading of a generating facility, and the Board is required to hold a public hearing to review such an application;

AND WHEREAS, NB Power is proposing environmental improvements, life extension and conversion from oil to Orimulsion® fuel for the Coleson Cove generating facility;

AND WHEREAS, prior to filing its evidence, NB Power is inviting the Board and members of the public, who would like to consider becoming intervenors, to an Information Session on the 15th day of August 2001 from 4:00 PM to 8:00 PM in Ballroom C of the Delta Brunswick Hotel in Saint John, New Brunswick;

AND WHEREAS NB Power has applied to this Board to hold a public hearing to review its evidence and, pursuant to Subsection 40.1(3) of the Act, make a recommendation as to whether the project should be undertaken.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- (a) The Board shall hold a public hearing to review the evidence to be filed by NB Power.
- (b) A Pre-Hearing conference shall be held in Ballroom C of the Delta Brunswick Hotel, Saint John, New Brunswick, on Friday the 14th day of September 2001 commencing at 10:00 o'clock in the forenoon and from day to day as necessary, when and where intervenors and NB Power should attend and make representations as to the date of the full public hearing and the procedure to be followed prior to and at the public hearing and as to any other relevant matters.
- (c) Notice of the date for the holding of the Pre-Hearing Conference in respect of the application and the procedure the Board intends to follow to facilitate the participation of intending intervenors, be published, in the form or substantially in the form attached hereto marked "A", in either the English or French language as may be appropriate having regard to the principal language of publication, twice in each of the following newspapers:
