# THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF PUBLIC UTILITIES OF NEW BRUNSWICK

IN THE MATTER OF an Application by New Brunswick Power Corporation for the approval of an Open Access Transmission Tariff.

### ORDER

WHEREAS New Brunswick Power Corporation ("NB Power") has applied to the Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities (the "Board") by Application dated the 21<sup>st</sup> day of June 2002 in connection with the approval of an Open Access Transmission Tariff. Such Tariff to include terms and conditions, including rates for transmission services and ancillary services, service agreements, interconnection agreements, a transmission expansion policy and the Standards of conduct under which service will be provided.

AND WHEREAS NB Power is required, pursuant to Section 56 of the Public Utilities Act, Chapter P-27 RSNB ("the Act") to make application to the Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities ("the Board") before charging or changing any charge, rate or toll or any Tariff in respect of transmission services or ancillary services;

AND WHEREAS NB Power has applied to this Board to hold a public hearing to review its evidence and, pursuant to Subsection 57 (2) (a) and (b) of the Act, to confirm, alter, reduce or modify the Tariff, and set the time at which the tariff is to take effect.

## NOW THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- (a) The Board shall hold a public hearing to review the evidence to be filed by NB Power.
- (b) A Pre-Hearing conference shall be held in the Montague Room of the Trade and Convention Center, One Market Square, Saint John, New Brunswick, on Monday the 12<sup>th</sup> day of August 2002 commencing at 10:00 o'clock in the forenoon, when and where Intervenors and NB Power should attend and make representations as to the date of the full hearing and the procedure to be followed prior to and at the public hearing and as to any other relevant matters.
- (c) Notice of the holding of the Pre-Hearing Conference in respect of the application and the procedure the Board intends to follow to facilitate the participation of Intervenors, be published, in the form or substantially in the form attached hereto marked "A", in either the English or French language as may be appropriate having regard to the principal language of publication, twice in each of the following newspapers:
