**IN THE MATTER** of an Application by Enbridge Gas New Brunswick Inc. to amend its Permit to Construct 2000-1

**NOTICE**

The Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities of New Brunswick (“Board”) has received an Application (the “Application”) from Enbridge Gas New Brunswick Inc. (“EGNB”) pursuant to subsection 22(1) of the Gas Distribution Act, 1999 to amend its Permit to Construct 2000-1 to allow it to construct high pressure, steel pipelines on Expansion Avenue, Old Black River Road, McIlveen Drive, Whitebone Way, Fairvale Blvd. and Connector Street, Saint John, New Brunswick (as shown on plans filed with the Application) in 2002 and to allow for further construction of high pressure polyethylene pipelines and high and extra-high pressure steel pipelines as part of its infill program in the municipalities subject to the Permit to Construct 2000-1 without the necessity of a public hearing process.

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Board has ordered the following:

1. A pre-hearing conference shall be held at the Board’s office at 15 Market Square, Suite 1400, Saint John, New Brunswick on August 19, 2002 commencing at 10:00 o’clock in the forenoon, when and where EGNB, intervenors and other interested parties should attend and make representations on the following:
  - (a) the type of proceeding to consider the Application;
  - (b) the procedure to be followed in respect of the proceeding; and
  - (c) any other matters in respect thereto.
  
2. Persons intending to intervene must notify the Board and EGNB, in writing, at the addresses below, no later than July 29, 2002, and

- (a) state whether the person intends to appear at the pre-hearing conference and the official language in which the person wishes to be heard;
- (b) set out the name of the person and any authorized representative of the person and the mailing address, address for personal service, telephone number and any other telecommunications numbers of the person or the person's authorized representative; and
- (c) establish that the person's interest justifies intervenor status in the proceeding.

3. Persons who do not wish to formally intervene but who wish to make comments to the Board regarding the proceeding must notify the Board and EGNB, in writing, at the addresses below, on or before July 29, 2002 of their intent to file a letter of comment, such letter to be sent to the Board and EGNB no later than August 8, 2002.

4. The Application and additional information provided to the Board in support of the Application, together with a copy of the Board's Order, will be placed on file for examination by interested parties, during normal business hours, at the office of the Board in Saint John, NB, at EGNB's office in Fredericton, NB, at the municipal offices of the towns of St. George and Oromocto, NB and at the office of GCP Bristol at 246 Lutz Street, Moncton, NB no later than 5:00 p.m. on July 5, 2002.
