Review of Maximum Margins, Delivery Costs and Full Service Charge for Gasoline and Other Petroleum Products

The New Brunswick Energy and Utilities Board ("Board") will conduct a public hearing, pursuant to Section 14(1) of the *Petroleum Products Pricing Act* (S.N.B., Chapter P-8.05), to review the following issues:

- 1. Maximum margins for petroleum wholesalers
- 2. Maximum margins for petroleum retailers
- 3. Maximum delivery costs that can be charged by petroleum wholesalers
- 4. The maximum full service charge that can be charged by petroleum retailers

The Board has engaged an independent consultant to review the maximum margins, delivery costs and full service charge and to provide the Board with a report on his findings.

A public hearing will begin at 9:30 AM, Monday, October 6, 2008 at the Delta Fredericton Hotel, 225 Woodstock Road, Fredericton, NB.

Members of the public may participate at the hearing in one of two ways:

- (a) Register with the Board by July 28, 2008, indicating their choice of language for the hearing and providing the names of any authorized representatives and their mailing address, e-mail address and telephone number. Registered parties may submit written questions to the consultant and may provide their own evidence. If they provide evidence they will be required to answer written questions and to appear at the public hearing to answer questions in person. The specific timing for this process will be announced once parties have registered.

- (b) Provide a written submission to the Board by September 29, 2008.
